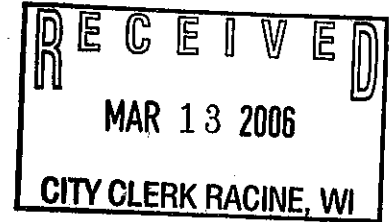

We, a group of Racine residents, and students at the University of Wisconsin- Parkside respectfully request an opportunity to address the issue of the proposed cuts to the Route 9 bus service.

Not all the people who ride this bus to Kenosha are students. A recent petition drive to keep the bus running, shows that there are Racine residents, who work in Kenosha, and have no other transportation available to them.

Activities, seminars, workshops and films, also draw people from Racine to Kenosha and the UW campus. A group of twelve developmentally delayed young people come out to Parkside just for this purpose, as do potential students from Racine high schools.

Someone should be looking at those paying fare, and not students, that are not counted by Parkside administration. This cut will affect more than just students.

A chance to address both the City Council, and the Transit and Parking Committee is greatly appreciated.
