Stats. 253.16, will be transferred from the City to the Racine County Human Services Department (County) through an Intergovernmental Transfer. The County will become a subcontractor of the City under Sec. VIII of the Contract between DHS and the City. Pursuant to Sec. VIII B. of the Contract, the City retains fiscal and programmatic responsibility for fulfillment by the County and its vendors of the terms and conditions of the Contract.</p> <p>These funds are to be utilized to promote a comprehensive strength-based approach to serving families using coordinated, family-centered, community-driven, and culturally-competent services, including home visiting. The City will use Racine County and the County's vendors to directly perform services.
