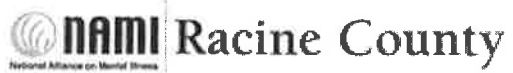
Each year for the past few years we have had an event called "Go Green Monday" to increase the awareness of mental illness in our community. Throughout the day, people will rally on Monument Square holding signs about mental illness and about recovery there from. In 1990, Congress established the first full week of October as Mental Illness Awareness Week. Since then, mental health advocates across the country have joined with their communities to sponsor activities for public education about mental illness.

NAMI Racine County would like to request the sponsoring of the following parking meters which would be found on Main Street (West side of the square), eight meters on the north end of Monument Square by the vacant building and approximately seven meters on 5th Street be hooded on Monday, October 2nd, 2017 from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm in order to allow participants places to park at no charge, while they attend the rally. This is in support of Mental Illness Awareness Week that will be kicking off our week here in Racine County.
