State Municipal Agreement - State ID: 2703-00-04/24/74

STP-Urban, 16th Street – STH 32 to Main Street

We have received a State/Municipal Agreement for STP-Urban, 16th Street – STH 32 to Main Street.

16th Street is a two-lane urban cross-section roadway with two 12 ft. travel lanes and 8 ft. shoulders. The roadway width varies throughout the segment. Sidewalks are present. The pavement is asphalt over concrete or brick and it is in poor condition with an average PCI rating of 27. The route is classified as a minor arterial with an ADT of 3,800.

The proposed work is to reconstruct the road as an urban cross-section with curb and gutter and sidewalk. Bicycle accommodations will be addressed per Federal regulations. The total project length will be about 0.6 miles. Additional work will include storm sewers, standard system lighting, permanent and temporary pavement marking, and permanent and temporary signing. Non-participating items include sanitary sewer adjustments and items determined in design.

Project design, real estate and construction costs are funded with 80% Federal funding up to a maximum of \$1,474,976 for all Federally funded project phases when the Municipality agrees to provide the remaining 20% and all funds in excess of the \$1,474,976 Federal funding maximum, in accordance with the STP Urban program guidelines for projects in urbanized areas. Non-participating costs are 100% the responsibility of the municipality. The estimated cost of this project is \$1,943,720 with the City's share being \$468,744 and the State's share being \$1,474,976. The City share will be provided in the 2016-2025 Capital Improvement Plan budget.

If the Committee agrees, the appropriate action would be to approve the agreement and authorize the City Engineer to sign the agreement.
