EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Claimants Nancy and Jeffrey Mueller filed a claim with the City on September 5, 2023, requesting an unspecified amount in damages allegedly arising from damage to a fence at 2416 20th Street in Racine, occurring between April and October 2022, during a scheduled alley work project. The contracted party performing this alley work was LaLonde Contractors, Inc. The contractor, rather than the City, is liable for damages allegedly resulting from this contracted alley work project, and the City has notified the claimant of the contractor's name and address so they may file their claim with the contractor. Because the City is not liable for these alleged damages and due to defects in the claim as filed, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that this claim be disallowed.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

Claimants Nancy and Jeffrey Mueller, of 2416 20th Street, Racine, Wisconsin 53403, filed a claim with the City on September 5, 2023, requesting an unspecified amount in damages allegedly arising from damage to a fence at 2416 20th Street in Racine, occurring between April and October 2022, during a scheduled alley work project.

The contracted party performing this alley work was LaLonde Contractors, Inc. The contractor, rather than the City, is liable for damages allegedly resulting from this contracted alley work project, and the City has notified the claimants of the contractor's name and address so they may file their claim with the contractor.

32 The notice of the circumstances of this claim was not timely filed. Wisconsin Statute section 893.80(1d)(a) requires a claimant to file written notice of the circumstances of a claim within 120 days after 33 the event giving rise to the claim. In the instant case, the event giving rise to the claim allegedly occurred 34 between April and October 2022. When the City received notice of the circumstances of this claim on 35 September 5, 2023, it was well past the 120-day deadline. As such, the notice of circumstances for this 36 37 claim was untimely filed. 38 Furthermore, this claim fails to specify the damages sought, as required by law. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 893.80(1d)(b), a claim must contain an itemized statement of the relief sought. 39 Therefore, this claim is defective. 40 41 For the reasons set forth above, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that this 42 claim be disallowed. 43 44 **BUDGETARY IMPACT:** 45 Assuming the recommendation to disallow this claim is adopted, this item would have a \$0.00 impact on the City's budget. 46 47 **RECOMMENDED ACTION:** 48 That the disallowance of this claim be recommended for approval. 49
