June 6 - 8, 2011	Fecal Indicators – Problem or Solution (FIPS) Conference? (Edinburgh, Scotland)	Give an invited oral presentation and present a poster related to Racine research	The Laboratory Staff (Kinzelman and Anan'eva) participated in this international conference (150 participants from 28 countries). We presented a poster (Anan'eva) and gave an oral presentation (Kinzelman). Subsequent to the presentations we were asked to submit papers for their juried conference proceedings to be published in 2012. Travel expenses were covered by grants.
June 14, 2011	Bay Area Restoration Council, Environment Canada (Hamilton, Ontario)	Review 2 local beaches and give presentation	At the invitation of the Bay Area Restoration Council two Hamilton, Ontario beaches were reviewed and a presentation was given about Racine beach restoration efforts at Environment Canada. The presentation was attended by local, provincial, and federal representatives. Travel expenses were covered by the Bay Area Restoration Council.
June 15 - 17, 2011	Great Lakes Cities Initiative Annual Meeting	Attend annual meeting as Mayor Dickert's representative	Racine led a breakout session for mayors on managing beaches and coasts.  It was well attended.
June 23, 2011	WI Coastal Management Council Meeting	Attend bi-annual meeting as Mayor Dickert's proxy	Mayor Dickert is appointed by the Governor to serve on the WI Coastal Management Council. At this meeting we reviewed the call for proposal for the next funding cycle. Travel costs were covered by the State of WI.
June 28, 2011	Bay Lake Regional Planning Commission (BLRPC)	Interview engineering firms	Interviewed four firms as part of a panel. This is part of our 3-year contract with the BLRPC. We will receive \$1100 for services rendered on June 28 <sup>th</sup> .
