The Wisconsin Fair Housing Network (WFHN) is a coalition of people representing individuals, public agencies and private organizations dedicated to the education and promotion of fair housing throughout Wisconsin. WFHN meets quarterly to exchange ideas and to discuss events occurring within the State about fair housing. WFHN bi-annually sponsors a fair housing conference. WFHN annually sponsors fair housing awards program to recognize individuals and organizations that have made significant contributions to further fair housing and a fair housing poster and essay contest. The latter activity is geared to school age children. WFHN produces a calendar that includes key civil rights events and incorporates winning entries from the Poster and Essay Contest. State agencies that participate in the WFHN are the Department of Commerce, the Department of Workforce Developments' Equal Rights Division, the Department of Regulations and Licensing, and the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority. Other members include the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, local governments, fair housing organizations, and housing industry groups.
