January 4, 2017	Kenosha County Parks	Discuss Grant Proposal	Discussed ability to provide water quality testing services as part of a grant application to do riparian restoration in Petrifying Springs Park. Kenosha County submitted their grant application on January 13, 2017.
January 17, 2017	United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA)	Virtual Beach Steering Committee	Participated in quarterly steering committee call.
January 18, 2017	Wisconsin Department of Agriculture / Trade and Consumer Protection (WDATCP)	Biannual Inspection	Physical space, laboratory SOPs, QA-QC documents and staff analytical skills were evaluated as part of our biannual inspection, required to maintain certification as a water and dairy laboratory in the State of WI. Only one minor deficiency was noted.
