Amendment No. 1 to Contract 20170014, PS – 2017 Pavement Inspection and Planning,

AECOM, Consultant

We are submitting Amendment No. 1 on the above contract. Amendment No. 1's project limits consists of the blocks on Twenty-First Street from Racine Street to Grand Avenue and the block of Howe Street from Twenty-First Street to Twentieth Street. The purpose is to investigate the project area and develop solutions for repair of the subgrade and roadway. The project purpose is proposed to be accomplished in three phases including Immediate, Near Term and Longer Term solutions.

The purpose of the Immediate phase is to mitigate the potential hazards related to known voids. The purpose of the Near Term phase is to provide solutions to minimize disruption to area residents/travelers and City services (e.g. solid waste, snow plowing, street sweeping) prior to completing a comprehensive investigation and implementing longer term solutions. The purpose of the Longer Term phase is to re-open the street to traffic and normal use in advance of the planned 2020 design and construction project.

The agreement was approved under Resolution 0067-17, dated February 22, 2017 in the not-to-exceed cost of \$81,500.00. Amendment No. 1 is in the not-to-exceed amount of \$25,150.00, bringing the total amount of the contract to \$106,650.00.

Funding to defray the cost of the amendment is available in Org-Object 45040-57500, Paving.

If the Committee agrees, appropriate action would be to approve the amendment and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into the agreement.
