Dear Mr. Brown:

As you know, the City of Racine has previously issued its Variable/Fixed Rate Demand Solid Waste Disposal Refunding Revenue Bonds (Republic Services, Inc. Project) Series 2004, in the aggregate principal amount of \$20,000,000 (the "Bonds"). Republic Services, Inc. (the "Company") wishes to make the following amendments to the Indenture of Trust dated as of March 1, 2004 (the "Original Indenture") between the City of Racine and Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, as trustee:

- 1. amend the definition of "Maturity Date" in Section 1.01 of the Original Indenture;
- 2. amend paragraph 6 of the Bond form to add a mandatory tender; and
- 3. amend Section 5.01(a)(2) of the Original Indenture to change the number of days interest to be covered by a Letter of Credit.

Section 10.02 of the Original Indenture authorizes the execution and delivery of a supplemental indenture to make such amendments. To that end, the Company requests preliminary consideration and final adoption of a resolution authorizing such amendments at the meetings of the Common Council on April 20, 2009 and May 6, 2009, respectively.
