

Petition Supplement

Applicant: Taylor Ave Food Mart, LLC., dba Taylor Food Mart

Property located at: **2056 Taylor Avenue**

Applicant is applying to exceed the quota restriction for a "Class A" license.

- 1) Quota restriction on the number of licenses.
 - a. Section 6-97(a) of the ordinance sets the quota for "Class A" licenses at 24.
 - b. The city is currently over quota at 26 active "Class A" licenses.
 - c. Granting this petition to exceed the quota would bring the total number of "Class A" licenses to 27.
- 2) Requirement for exceeding quota restriction.
 - a. The common council may, by a two-thirds vote of all members present, grant a new "Class A" license in excess of the quota if all four criteria listed under Section 6-97(d) have been met:
 - b. Criteria (a) Applicant shall submit to the city clerk a petition for exceeding the quota, to include a business plan of operation and relevant experience, background and signatures of individuals, officers or agent, as well as signature of the owner of the land as required under section 6-54;
 - c. Criteria (b) Applicant shall supply proof of ownership or lease of a building that is properly zoned for the proposed venture;
 - d. Criteria (c) Applicant shall show that the proposed establishment will have a greater economic impact upon the community than simply the addition of another tavern, liquor store, convenience store or restaurant; and
 - e. Criteria (d) Applicant shall show that the proposed establishment will benefit the community by substantially improving the tax base (i.e. the establishment will extensively rehabilitate a blighted or deteriorated building, construct a new building on vacant land, or benefit the community by conferring some other tangible and substantial improvement for the area).
