**Subject:** (Direct Referral) Communication from the Racine County Executive Safety Committee requesting permission to place a crosswalk yield sign on the 700 block of Wisconsin Avenue.

Recommendation of the Traffic Commission on 06-15-15:

Recommends that the request to place a crosswalk yield sign on the 700 block of Wisconsin Avenue be approved.

Further recommends that Racine County be permitted to place the sign from 7:30 A.M. to 5:30 P.M. on business days, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Racine County is responsible for procuring the movable "yield-to-pedestrian within crosswalk" sign and maintaining it.
- 2. The sign meets all the requirements of the latest edition of the FHWA (Federal Highway Association) Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).
- 3. The sign is placed on the centerline of the roadway on Wisconsin Avenue, in the painted crosswalk mid-block between Seventh Street and Eighth Street, as to not obstruct vehicular traffic.
- 4. The sign will be removed by Racine County during snow & ice operations, and as directed by the Commissioner of Public Works for street maintenance or construction.
- 5. Racine County enters into a hold harmless agreement with the City of Racine for placement of movable "yield-to-pedestrian within crosswalk" sign in City right-of-way.

#### Fiscal Note: N/A

John Rooney read a request from the Racine County Executive Safety Committee requesting permission to place a crosswalk yield sign in the 700 block of Wisconsin Avenue. He read the request and noted permission was being requested to place a portable pedestrian yield sign in the mid-block crossing between the Law Enforcement Center and the Racine County Courthouse. He noted a similar request was brought to the Traffic Commission back in 2007 by the West Racine Business Association and the Downtown Racine Corporation to place similar devices at intersections without signals in the two business districts. He noted that while the Traffic Commission did not oppose the request, there was no money from either business association to purchase the portable signs, nor to pay DPW to maintain them or have the business districts maintain the signs themselves. He noted the Pedestrian Yield Sign that was requested to be placed does meet the requirements of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. He noted, as staff to the Traffic Commission, he had no objections to the request and noted this was actually one of the locations that was suggested to place one back in 2007.

Mark Yehlen indicated that the County should be responsible for moving the sign during snow and ice operations as Wisconsin Avenue is a bare pavement street.

Alexandra Tillmann appeared before the Commission and noted that the signs would be maintained by the Deputies that serve the LEC and Racine County Courthouse. She asked that the signs be placed from 7:30 A.M. to 5:30 P.M. on business days.

John Rooney suggested the following conditions: that Racine County is responsible for procuring the sign and maintaining it, the sign meets the latest edition of the MUTCD, the sign is placed on center line of the roadway in the crosswalk and not obstruct vehicular traffic, the sign will be removed during snow and ice operations or as directed by the Commissioner of Public Works for street maintenance or construction and that Racine County enter into a hold harmless agreement with the City for the placement of a movable sign in City right-of-way.

After further discussion, a motion was made by Yehlen, seconded by Morgenroth to approve. Passed unanimously.
