Mr. Rooney,

I apologize that the City of Racine was not contacted about adding sidewalks along WIS 31 from WIS 20 to County MM, project id 2390-09-00/70. I see that the City of Racine / Mt. Pleasant Boundary extends to or crosses WIS 31 several times along this segment.

As you see in the attached exhibit from Bill Sasse, Mt Pleasant is proposing sidewalk to be included with the state project above at specific locations along the project. If Mt. Pleasant approved the proposed sidewalk per the attached exhibit it would not make sense to include sidewalk on the City of Racine parcels that do not connect to sidewalk on either side. The one segment that would need to be discussed is the east side of WIS 31 between Kinzie Ave and Graceland Blvd. The City currently has sidewalk along the frontage road, but it would need to be extended slightly to connect to Mt. Pleasants proposed sidewalk.

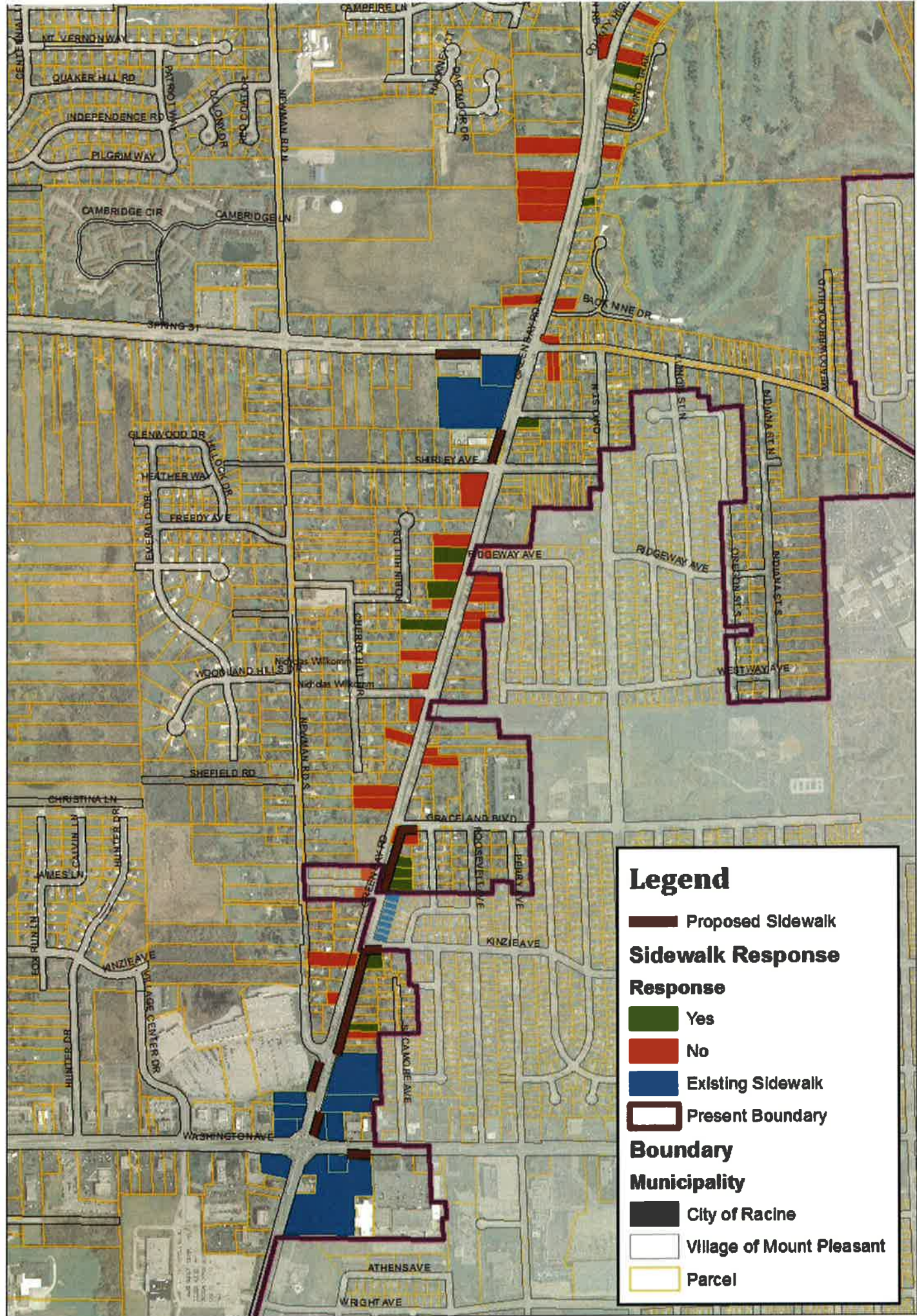
