EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Mayor Mason requests that the Finance & Personnel Committee recommend approval of a resolution supporting a grant application for \$2,000,000 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services under the Community Project Funding / Congressionally Directed Spending projects funding program to fund the Racine Community Health Clinic project.

Background:

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Community Project Funding / Congressional Directed Spending has notified the City that it is eligible to apply for this grant. U.S. Senator Tammy Baldwin sponsored this directed spending of \$2,000,000 in the Omnibus Appropriations Legislation for Fiscal Year 2022.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

No additional City funds will be allocated as a result of receiving this grant. The grant does not require a local match. The grant control number is #00437.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Staff recommends the request sponsored by Mayor Mason to approve the resolution supporting a grant application for \$2,000,000 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and be forwarded to the Common Council with a recommendation for approval.
