Call To Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M.

Approval of Minutes for the October 11, 2011 Meeting.

The minutes for the October 11, 2011 meeting were approved as printed. Motion made by DeHahn, seconded by Morgenroth. Passed unanimously.

Subject: Communication from Lutheran High School requesting permission to use city right-of-way and parks for their Tech Trek on Wednesday, November 2, 2011.

Recommendation of the Public Works and Services Committee on 10-25-11: That permission be granted to Racine Lutheran High School to use city bike paths for their Tech Trek to be held on Wednesday, November 2, 2011.

Further recommend that permission be granted with the following stipulations:

- A. A hold harmless agreement is executed;
- B. A liability insurance certificate is filed prior to the event.
- C. Any overtime costs incurred by any City department to assist with this project is charged to the sponsor;
- D. That access to the pathway for general public use is available at all times.

Further recommend that the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services and Chief of Police provide limited assistance, in the interest

of public safety, to implement this event.

Fiscal Note: There will be nominal costs to various City departments, on a regular shift basis, to assist in implementing this event.

Tom Molbeck appeared before the Committee and noted that quite a bit of the Tech Trek for Lutheran High School was in the City Parks and they were not asking for exclusive use. He had no objections to the use. He noted the typical requirements for such events.

Motion made by Marcus, seconded by DeHahn to approve. Passed unanimously.

Subject: Communication from the Chief Building Inspector submitting a change to Municipal Code Ordinance, Sec. 18-466 - Office of chief plumbing inspector.

Jon Christensen appeared before the Committee. He asked that changes be made to the plumbing code by Ordinance to permit the Plumbing Inspector to shut the water off if there is a known safety issue that would arise. The primary reason for doing this would be to eliminate potential health hazards as it relates to cross connections. Alderman Weidner and Alderman Marcus were concerned that the scope of the Ordinance change was to broad. Alderman Shields asked that the item be deferred while the Chief Building Inspector and City Attorney review the proposed language change.

Motion made by Shields, seconded by Marcus to defer. Passed unanimously.
