Re: Amendment No. 1 to Contract 2024024 – Professional Services Agreement for Uptown Racine Green Alley & Infrastructure

Dear Alder Jones:

The City of Racine is desirous of providing a green alley and other green infrastructure in Uptown Racine. The City applied for and received an Urban Nonpoint Source & Storm Water (UNPS&SW) Management Grant in November 2024 to partially fund this improvement project approved in the 2024-33 CIP. With the grant award and acceptance by the Common Council in December 2024, bidding and construction will occur in 2025.

Amendment No. 1 is hereby submitted for your review. The services included in the amendment include; provide 90% design to WDNR for review, provide 100% design and bid documents after WDNR review, and provide construction management services for the project. The project includes two green alleys and a bio-filtration park in a City-owned parking lot and right-of-way, located south of Washington Avenue between Owen and Junction Avenues.

The total cost of this amendment is \$72,2500 and ~70% of the green infrastructure design will be funded by said grants. Funding for this work is available in:

If the committee agrees, the appropriate action would be to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into the agreement.
