
McAuliffe's On The Square is the sole proprietorship of John Patrick McAuliffe and will be a small downtown nightspot.

I currently rent from the Pugh family and live at 309 4th St Racine.


I am active in many non profit organizations and community organizations. I also serve as the vice president of The Racine City Tavern League and am a state representative for the TLW.
