REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF: December 2009

HIGHLIGHTS:

- On December 5, 2009, the Racine on the Lake Tobacco Free Coalition along with Western Racine County Health Department, Caledonia/Mt. Pleasant Health Department and Focus on Community hosted a Smoke Free Air Law Implementation Event at Marcus Theatres in Sturtevant. The Smoke Free Air Law event provided an opportunity for youth, Coalition members and health department employees provided smoke free air education. The Coalition was able to collect 113 completed postcards from people who support smoke free air policies.
- On December 15, 2009 the Racine on the Lake Tobacco Free Coalition provided information regarding the new Statewide Smoke Free Air Law to the City of Racine Committee of the Whole. A fifteen minute presentation was followed by opportunities for the Common Council members to ask questions about the law and how it pertains to the city of Racine and its residents.
- On December 18, 2009 the Racine on the Lake Tobacco Free Coalition provided information regarding the new Statewide Smoke Free Air Law to the Sanitarians of the City of Racine Environmental Health Division. This provided the sanitarians with an opportunity to be prepared and have the resources they need to answer questions that new and existing restaurant and bar owners may have about the new law.
