Renee Messing from Clifton-Gunderson summarized the management letter regarding the 2010 audit. Items addressed in the management letter were repeats from previous years. Issues regarding segregation of duties and preparation of financial statements can all be addressed by hiring more staff or hiring outside CPA's at considerable cost to further comply with GASB standards. She noted that may clients have the same issues. It is felt by the Water Utility management that it is not in the financial best interest, at this time, to hire more staff or additional outside CPA firms to address this issue.
