Date	Meeting	Purpose	Outcome
July – August 2024	Overdose Prevention Trainings	Increase community awareness and ability to respond to opioid overdoses	Conducted several trainings with local organizations about recognizing and responding to opioid overdoses. Trained 60 total individuals and provided 30 Narcan kits, with several individuals intending to serve as secondary distributors.
July 13, 2024	Child Passenger Safety Event	Educate parents and caregivers on proper car seat usage	Several staff participated in an event with a local partner, providing car seat checks and information to parents/caregivers. Conducted eight car seat checks through this event.
July 16, 2024	Harm Reduction Program Presentation	Increase local awareness of harm reduction program	Presented information to participants in the Drug- Free Communities Program through Focus on Racine so other local partners have greater awareness of the PHD's Harm Reduction Program and the services available through it.
August 6, 2024	National Night Out (NNO) 2024	Interact with community members and share program information	Six staff members were able to participate in two separate NNO events. They used games and activities to educate and interact with children and adults, providing information about department services as well as general health information.
August 6, 2024	Tuberculosis (TB) Contact Investigation Fundamentals	Learn the basics for initiating a TB contact investigation	Newest Public Health Nurse had the chance to learn from others about TB contact investigations through exercises and discussions. Also addressed were interviewing skills and cultural competency.
August 8, 2024	RUSD Back to School Event	Share information about back to school immunizations for RUSD families	Interacted with dozens of RUSD families at the Park HS event, sharing relevant information about immunizations and other services. Assisted eligible families with making immunization appointments.
August 21, 2024	Dual-Rapid HIV Testing Training	Provide another method for rapid HIV testing	Seven staff members learned how to use a second type of rapid HIV test and about the new "Dual-Rapid Algorithm" This provides for faster confirmation of HIV infection without the need for laboratory analysis, enabling staff to initiate Partner Services sooner and connect clients with care in a more timely manner.
