5. <u>12-8283</u> Subject: Authorization of the General Manager to Enter Into a

Revised Memo of Understanding (MOU) with OpenCel for the Installation of their Technology

Recommendation: Approve

The General Manager explained that the Utility, with Black & Veatch's assistance, drafted a revised Memo of Understanding (MOU) for the installation of the OpenCel technology due to parameter changes. The General Manager requested authorization to enter into this revised MOU agreement with OpenCel for procurement of the system.

6. <u>12-8118</u> **Subject:** Submittal of the Pretreatment Rates for 2013

8. <u>12-8181</u> **Subject:** Proposal from Strand Associates, Inc. for a Concrete Condition Assessment of the Wastewater Plant

Recommendation: Approve

The General Manager stated that he received a proposal from Strand Associates, Inc. for concrete condition assessment at the Wastewater Plant. He noted that four to five areas need to be repaired, and after the assessment, the Utility will go out for bids for this construction project. The General Manager stated that this proposal is in the amount of \$42,900.00 for time and materials, and recommends approval.

A motion was made by Ronald D. Hart, seconded by Thomas Bunker, that this be Approved. The motion PASSED by a Voice Vote.
