



## May Admissions Attendance 2022-2025




May 2025 Attendance by Hour

- o 1.0 Dom. Ferret Linguini is on digestive meds for possible kidney issues.
- 1.0 Hartmann's Mountain Zebra foal is doing well and has been introduced to the exhibit with 0.1 Promise

- o 0.0.1 African Penguin chick hatched 5-3-25.
- o 0.2 Red Kangaroos, Gigi and Winnie are set to arrive mid-June.
- o 30.30 Madagascar Hissing Cockroaches are set to arrive mid-June.

- Continuing frequent hoof work and training with 1.1 Hartmann's Mountain Zebra, 1.0
   Masai giraffe, 1.1 Eastern black rhinos
- Working on setup for voluntary x-rays with primates
- Working on voluntary cardiac ultrasound 1.0 Orangutan
- Have begun formal observations of 1.0 Fossa and 1.1 Orangutan to determine exhibit use and behavioral budgets.
- Racine Zoo has contracted (gratis) with WisCon Safety, to assist in evaluating the zoo's safety protocols and overall grounds. Will be onsite in July.
