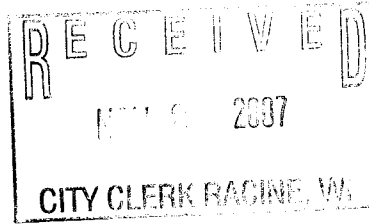

The Racine Fire Department is in the process of replacing their Automated External Defibrillators (AED's). They have offered to donate their used AED's to the Racine City Hall and City Hall Annex buildings. These models do not require special training or certification for use.

It would be feasible to place the AED's inside the glass cabinets that house the fire extinguishers located on each floor of City Hall. This would not compromise the aesthetics of the building. A similar arrangement could be made in the City Hall Annex building.

I request that the appropriate committee approve of the donation of the AED's and that a plan be developed for their future maintenance by the Department of Public Works.
