I hereby request permission to apply for funding from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Association/Great Lakes International Environmental Laboratory. Funding, if granted, would be used to develop a beach management/classification system for the Great Lakes with the ability to forecast contamination events and minimize risks to human health.
