SUBJECT: Communication sponsored by Alder Land on behalf of the City Attorney's Office submitting the claim of Bailey Berger and Sam Scarlato for consideration for disallowance.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Bailey Berger and Sam Scarlato filed a claim with the City of Racine requesting reimbursement of \$14,478.05 for damages allegedly caused to their sewer lateral when the Racine Water Utility's contractor, A.W. Oakes and Son Incorporated, installed a new water main in the vicinity of 3047 90th Street in Sturtevant, Wisconsin. The claimants first discovered this issue on or about November 21, 2026. The Racine Water Utility contracted with A.W. Oakes and Son Incorporated to perform this water main project. The contractor, rather than the City or the Racine Water Utility, is liable for damages allegedly resulting from this contracted water main project, and the City has notified the claimants of the contractor's name and address so they may file their claim with the contractor. Because, by the terms of its contract with A.W. Oakes and Son Incorporated, the City is not liable for these alleged damages, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that this claim be disallowed.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

Bailey Berger and Sam Scarlato, of 3047 90th Street, Sturtevant, Wisconsin 53177, filed a claim with the City of Racine requesting reimbursement of \$14,478.05 for damages allegedly caused to their sewer lateral when the Racine Water Utility's contractor, A.W. Oakes and Son Incorporated, installed a new water main in the vicinity of 3047 90th Street in Sturtevant, Wisconsin. The claimants first discovered

36 address so they may file their claim with the contractor. Because, by the terms of its contract with A.W.
