

To whom it may concern,

My name is Ben Schoettel. I am one of the volunteer leaders at Racine Community Church of the Nazarene on 8440 Spring St. Mount Pleasant, WI 53406.

I am requesting permission on behalf of our church to facilitate a 5k run/walk with all of the money raised from the event going to fund our local mission work in the Racine community.

The requested date for the event is May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The time frame we are requesting is from 4:00pm to 9:00pm to allow enough time for setup and tear down prior to and following after the run/walk. The race is planned to start at 6:00pm and end at 7:30pm.

We will not be setting up any tents or stages. The only area outside of the race route that we would be using is the parking lots by the playground and oasis to park our vehicles if there are spaces available. We will not need any additional areas to use because our plan is to just run the race and then go to our church building for additional activities.

The estimated start/stop location would be on the lake pathway just south of Hamilton St. We would then follow the pathway north to Melvin St and then turn around and head back south to the start/finish line near Hamilton St. I will provide a marked Google map copy for reference.

There will be no alcohol or food served at our event. We will provide water stations at our own expense and will clean up everything afterwards.

We are planning our route so that we do not interfere or cross any main city streets or traffic and I have already checked with the Racine Police Dept to get clearance for the event.

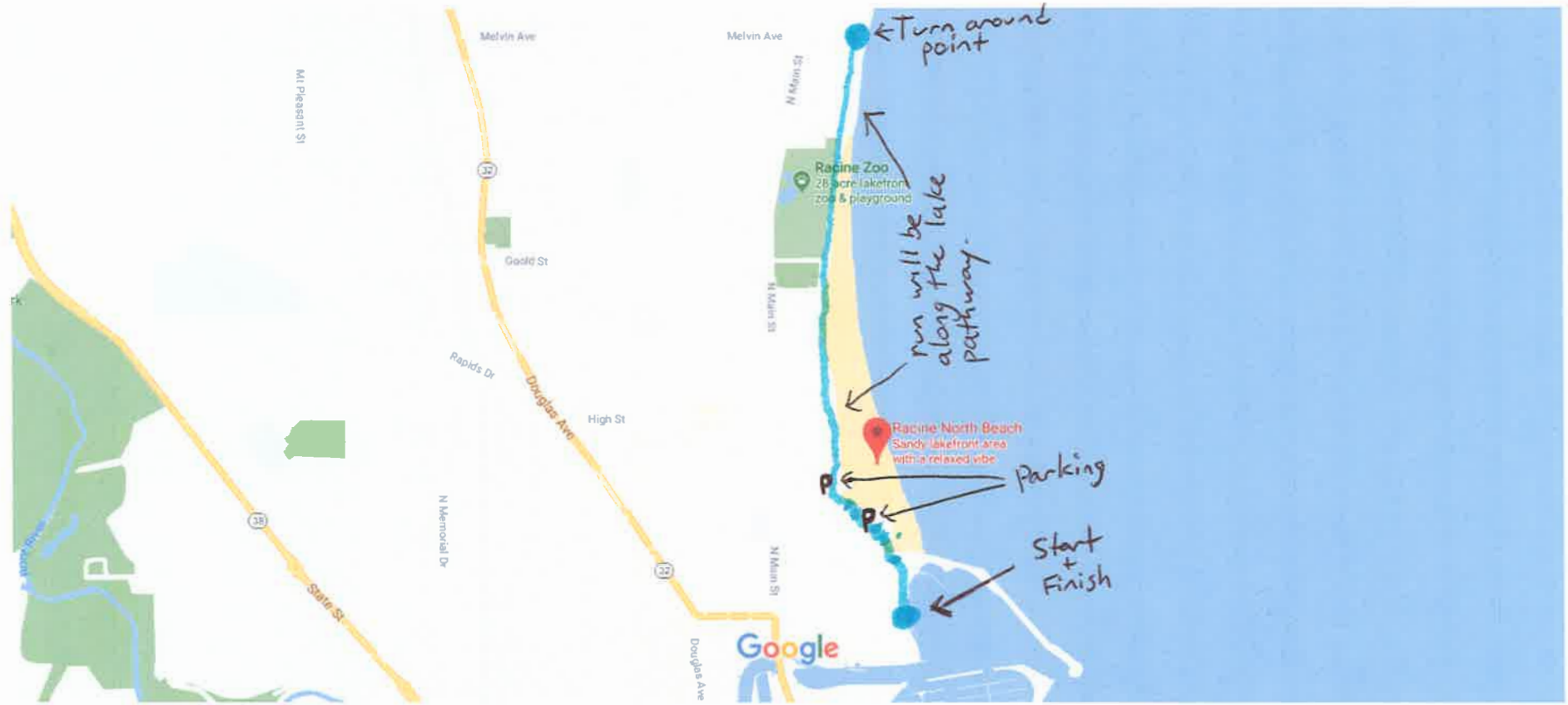
We will have simple start/finish banners, cones, and flags for marking our route as well as standing volunteers. We will make sure everything is removed after the event is over.
