WHEREAS, the Authority will allow employees from US EPA access to inspect the grant sites or facilities, and grant records; and

WHEREAS, the Authority and/or its authorized agents will submit all necessary documentation to accompany any pay requests to be submitted to WDNR.

IT IS, THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT, The Authority requests funds and assistance available from the US EPA Area Wide Planning Grant funds and will comply with rules for the program; and

HEREBY AUTHORIZES, Brian F. O'Connell, Executive Director, or his authorized agent to act on the behalf of the Authority: submit an application to US EPA for Area Wide Planning Grant funds to aid in the development of detailed reuse plans for brownfield sites in the RootWorks redevelopment area, sign documents, and take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete approved grant activities.
