Subject: (Direct Referral) Request from Eddie Evans to re-establish a car wash at 1614 Douglas Avenue. (Res.09-1532)

Commissioner Marcus opened the public hearing on this item at 4:30 p.m.

Director O'Connell reviewed the application and provided background information on the property. He advised it was formerly a mechanical car wash and the current request is for a hand wash and detaling service.

The applicant, Eddie Evans, 1614 Douglas Avenue, was present. He explained that his goal is to change the previous auto wash into a hand wash and detailing business. All interior machines have been removed and all washing a detailing will be done by hand. The traffic circulation will not change.

Ms. Johanneck stated staff has not yet received a site plan showing the interior layout of the car wash, the traffic circulation within the site, or the parking areas on the property. Mr. Evans advised the workers arrive daily with him (he brings them and takes them home in the evening. He was advised on-site parking is required per

the zoning code.

The recommended conditions of approval were given to the applicant for his review.

Alderman Kaplan spoke in favor of the request. However, he did note that these types of businesses can lead to people "hanging out". He advised that other car washes do the final finishing of the cars right outside the front doors, as requested by Mr. Evans, and encouraged this to be allowed.

Ms. Johanneck advised no comments were received in favor or against the proposal from surrounding properties.

Commissioner Marcus noted that this item has gone to the Access Corridor Committee, which recommended approval but also cited concerns. Ms. Johanneck advised Access Corridor's concerns were incorporated into the staff review and recommendations.

Mr. Sadowski advised that Mr. David Namowicz contacted him and is in search of clarification on the number of vehicles to be serviced at one time. Commissioner Marcus asked the applicant how many vehicles he could service at one time. Mr. Evans advised he can fit up to ten (10) cars in the building at a time. Ms. Johanneck advised her intent was to limit the number of vehicles being served at the last stage in the process (drying) to three (3), to limit congestion of vehicles and any blockage onto Douglas Avenue. She reiterated that staff needed an interior plan to determine more detail how Mr. Evans' business is going to work within the site, how the drying area will be utilized, etc. The applicant will be responsible for getting a revised plan to staff.

Alderman Helding arrived at 4:45 p.m. and was briefed on the discussion of the item. Commissioner Marcus asked Mr. Evans how many vehicles will be parked there overnight. His response was one to two, and the vehicles would be parked inside. Staff said it will add to the conditions that there will be not overnight exterior storage of vehicles.

Ms. Johanneck clarified that staff will be asking for signage and that approval of signage requires approval of the Access Corridor Committee and the Department of City Development.

Alderman Kaplan asked about an old pole in the front and wondered if it would be grandfathered as a sign pole because it's existing. Several individuals noted that the pole has no signage on it or any supporting signage framework, the applicant advised there used to be a light on it. Director O'Connell and Alderman Helding stated the pole is not grandfathered.

Commissioner Marcus asked if there was anyone to speak in opposition of the conditional use. No one came forward.

Commissioner Marcus closed the public hearing at 4:50 p.m.

This was the noticed public hearing only. No action was taken on the item as there was no quorum present.*
