

## DIVISION 2. BOARD OF ELECTRICAL APPEALS\*

Sec. 18-626. Appointments; composition; secretary; quorum.

The board of electrical appeals, consisting of seven members, shall be appointed by the mayor, subject to confirmation by the common council, and shall consist of an electrical engineer, an electrical contractor, a journeyman electrician, and four city residents not engaged or in any way connected with the electrical trade, contracting or supply. The chief electrical inspector shall serve as secretary of the board, and all members of the board shall serve without compensation. Four members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, but no recommendations for issuance, modification, suspension or revocation of a contractor's license shall be adopted except by a majority vote of all members of the board.

Sec. 18-627. Powers and duties.

The board of electrical appeals shall act with like jurisdiction and powers and subject to the same procedures in the interpretation of this article and the provisions thereof relative to the use of alternate types of construction and materials as is possessed by the board of building appeals in the administration of article II of this chapter, and every provision of article II, division 2 of this chapter, except for the method of appointment, shall apply to this article and to the chief electrical inspector and the board of electrical appeals as though set forth fully in this article.

Sec. 18-628. Meetings.

The board of electrical appeals shall meet in May and October of each year and at the call of the chairman, and at such other times as it is deemed necessary by the board.
