Dear Commissioners:

As a result of recent high flows in the interceptor system and an attempt to quantify peak flow allocation for the parties of the sewer agreement, it is now necessary to install SCADA equipment at several locations in the system. The sewer agreement puts this responsibility on the Wastewater Utility to furnish, install, and maintain SCADA data collection equipment. The Parties are responsible to maintain their meters. The following locations need SCADA.

Mt. PL. Colonial Heights	\$30,000
Mt. PL. 24 <sup>th</sup> and Howe	\$30,000

The Village of Mt. Pleasant has offered the use of their staff when and if necessary to aid in the installation of this equipment at their locations. The current 2008 CIP will need to be amended in order to accomplish this project. The Utility has sufficient funds to perform the work. The revised budget will need to be approved by the Racine Common Council in accordance with the Sewer Agreement.
