Dear Mr. Rooney:

The purpose of this letter is to request City of Racine Department of Public Works approval for the installation of groundwater monitoring wells within the Gaslight Drive right-of-way (ROW) for environmental exploration purposes. This letter has been prepared by Geosyntec Consultants (Geosyntec) on behalf of We Energies.

Two monitoring wells are planned to be installed in the unpaved grass-covered median of the Gaslight Drive ROW north of 233 Lake Avenue and in the unpaved grass covered area just southwest of the Gaslight Drive and Gaslight Circle intersection (northwest of the parking garage) during the week of 19 December 2011. The monitoring well locations have been cleared by Diggers Hotline. The approximate monitoring well locations are depicted on the attached aerial photograph. The monitoring wells will be 2-inch diameter and will be completed with a flush mount cover. No saw-cutting or removal of pavement or curb and gutter will occur during this work.
