Alderman Mozol asked if the video system is working and Mr. Thomas explained that his system only holds 1 to 2 days of data. Mr. Thomas explained that he would like to upgrade his video system but is currently short on money. Ald. Mozol suggested updating the system.

Alderman Wisneski suggested that Mr. Thomas retrain his employees and emphasize the importance of not over-serving patrons. Ald. Wisneski also asked if Mr. Thomas was a member of the Tavern League. Mr. Thomas said no. Ald. Wisneski suggested that Mr. Thomas work with the Tavern League if possible as they have good training programs.
