It was assumed that there was current available traffic data to develop the transportation management plans. It turned out the data was not “current” and needed to be updated for Main Street and Spring Street.

The following response from WisDOT requires us to perform a review of potential historic sites within the Main Street project. *“According to the archival and literature search conducted by M.A.P., there are both individual properties that have been determined eligible and a potentially eligible residential historic district. Thus, this project does not qualify for the Screening List for architecture/history. I recommend that you prepare a Section 106 Review form and look toward checking the second box under Item IX (No historic properties affected).”* – Robert Newberry
