Recommendation of the Loan Board of Review on September 18, 2014: To approve the request of the Director of City Development to accept the offer of Marina M. Slack to purchase 1721 Villa Street, with contingencies as listed on attachment.

Fiscal Note: The property was acquired and rehabilitated through the NSP-3 program. The city will receive \$89,000 in proceeds minus commission and closing costs.

Subject: Request from the HOME Company regarding 26 rental units in the TowerView Neighborhood for a non-federal loan in the amount of \$120,000.

Fiscal Note: Home Company, Inc., is a non-profit corporation that has provided affordable housing in Racine for over 20 years. Home Company needs to refinance a \$120,000 balloon payment loan that it received from US HUD that is now due. The request is to borrow the \$120,000 from the city at 5% (our standard rate for landlord loans) over 8 years, resulting in an \$18,200 annual payment. The loan will be secured by a mortgage on the properties. Home Company also has agreed to make a voluntary "Fair Share" payment. There are sufficient non-federal funds available for this loan.
