Subject: (Direct Referral) Communication from the City Administrator and the City Attorney requesting to meet in closed session with the Committee of the Whole pursuant to Wis. Stat. §19.85(e) concerning the conduct of certain public business and pursuant to Wis. Stat. §19.85(g) concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is involved and litigation in which it is likely to become involved. Competitive and bargaining reasons require a closed session. Identifying the specific nature of the public business to be addressed may negatively affect the City's competitive advantage. (Res. No. 12-3239)

Recommendation of the Committee of the Whole: that the Common Council rescind Resolutions 10-2298, 10-2331, 10-2353, 10-2354, 11-2403, and 11-2404 as to any provision of any 2013-2014 collective bargaining agreement or memorandum of agreement between the City of Racine and any bargaining unit or employee association, that is a prohibited subject of bargaining under 2011 Wisconsin Act 10 and 2011 Wisconsin Act 32, or either of such Acts, and declare that any provision in such collective bargaining agreement or memorandum of agreement that is a prohibited subject of bargaining under 2011 Wisconsin Act 10 and 2011 Wisconsin Act 32, or either of such Acts, does not and shall not have effect at any time; and further that the City Attorney's office draft a resolution to such effect.
