DEPARTMENT: Public Health Administrator

REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF February, 2007

Highlights:

- Members of the Board of Health attended the February 6th, 2007 meeting of the Common Council to voice their concern with the announced closure of the health department laboratory by city administration. Based on multiple meetings I had with the Mayor prior to that date, he agreed to postpone the closure until April 30th, allow the hiring of a part time phlebotomist, and contract with Wheaton Franciscan Healthcare to run specified tests on uninsured clients.
- The first meeting of the newly formed Access to Healthcare workgroup took place on the 28th. This group has been formed to include the City of Racine Health Department, Health Care Network, Family Practice Center, and the new Community Clinic.
- Dr. DeRose met with Thelma Jones, Brenda Wilkinson, and I to discuss the lack of multiple dentists in the City of Racine who accept Medicaid. She is trying to increase the Medicaid reimbursement rate to 75% of cost. Their approach is "Two Cents for Tooth Sense" legislation that would implement a user fee of 2 cents on each can on soda (see attachments).
- The end of year review of DHFS grants was conducted on the 22nd. All grants procured met the required objectives for 2006.

This is the strongest ordinance in Southeastern Wisconsin.
