**SUBJECT:** Mortgage Subordination Request: Lincoln School

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

WHP-Lincoln School, LLC requests subordination of an existing mortgage on Lincoln School held by the City of Racine.

## **BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:**

- In 1990, the City of Racine Loan Board of Review approved a \$175,000 non-federal loan to Lincoln School Apartments, a senior affordable housing development.
- In 2007 Lincoln School was in financial distress; the Loan Board of Review amended the
  agreement with the project to preserve senior affordable housing within the city. (07-0617)
  Lincoln School Apartments (WHP-Lincoln School, LLC) paid the City \$29,296 and agreed to
  payments in lieu of property taxes.
- The remainder of the original mortgage, \$145,704, was restructured so that principal and interest are forgiven over a 14 year period (1/14th per year) provided the apartments remain affordable.
- The property is currently managed by Cardinal Capital and has both age and income residency restrictions.
- WHP-Lincoln School is currently refinancing the building and requests subordination of the amended mortgage note.

## **BUDGETARY IMPACT:**

Principal and interest are forgiven on the amended mortgage note annually by the Finance Department. Lincoln school pays \$7,630.00 to the City annual for PILOT.

## **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Staff recommends that the Loan Board of Review defer to City of Racine legal counsel.
