BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:	
The Claimant, Erie Insurance Company of the amount of \$12,391.28 for damages alleged	of Erie, Pennsylvania, filed this claim for reimbursement

This was the first break in the 20" transmission main that has been reported in this area, and, the City's Water Utility had no prior actual or constructive notice that this portion of the water main was compromised. Due to the size and severity of the break, the entire roadway was flooded, which resulted in the flooding of a basement located at 2125 Hamilton Avenue. After reimbursing the property owner for his losses, Erie Insurance filed this claim with the City in an attempt to recoup the payments it made in

In instances where the City has no constructive or actual knowledge of a defect in a water main,

accordance with the insurance policy held by the property owner.

the City cannot be held legally liable for the damages resulting from such a defect.

30 31 32	The City Attorney's Office recommends that this Committee deny the claim of Erie Insurance because the City had no constructive or actual knowledge of a defect in the water main in question, and therefore, the City is not legally liable for the alleged damages.

35 36	Assuming the recommendation to deny this claim is adopted, this item would have a \$0.00 impact on the City's budget.

39 40 41	If the recommendation to deny this claim is rejected, and the Committee recommends that this claim be paid by the City (contrary to any indication of the City's liability for the alleged damages), this item would have up to a \$12,391.28 impact on the City's 2018 claims budget.
