Because "TEMPORARY NO PARKING" is typically granted in this vicinity during the time of the fair, EUM runs a shuttle bus from remote parking. The church is requesting the City of Racine Traffic Engineer for the use of "TEMPORARY NO PARKING" signs to be used on the north side of the 1<sup>st</sup> block west of South Main Street on 11<sup>th</sup> Streets with restriction for the hours of 7:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. for Sunday, August 7, 2016. No Parking on the north side of the 200 block of 11<sup>th</sup> street allows the bus that is contracted for this day easier access to the church entrance.
