7th Street Intersection Recommendation

Public Works and Services Committee:

On Tuesday, September 22, 2009 the 7th Street Reconstruction Project CAC met to review the two intersection options for the 7th Street/Washington Avenue/6th Street intersection on the east side of City Hall. Prior to making their recommendations, the Committee reviewed the comments that were received from the Public Informational Meeting (PIM) held on August 12, 2009. Ninety-four percent of the people who commented on the intersection at the PIM preferred the roundabout.

Following a general discussion the CAC recommended unanimously that the roundabout option be implemented as the preferred solution. The roundabout configuration was to be consistent with the visualization presented at the PIM which included Downtown Racine signage on a short parapet wall in the center of the roundabout.
