Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department would like to meet with the Public Safety and Licensing Committee to request that formal bidding be waived and the Purchasing Agent be authorized to negotiate with Carrico Aquatic Resources for a 3 year chemical service contract, beginning May 2013 & ending November 2016, for the Laurel Clark Fountain.

Carrico Aquatic Resources is the current contractor providing and servicing the fountain chemical sanitation system. The contractor has offered to hold current pricing, excluding increases in fuel and chemical costs.

Funds are available in account 101.700.5630, Major Maintenance Replacement - Parks.

Staff will be available at the meeting to discuss this in greater detail.
