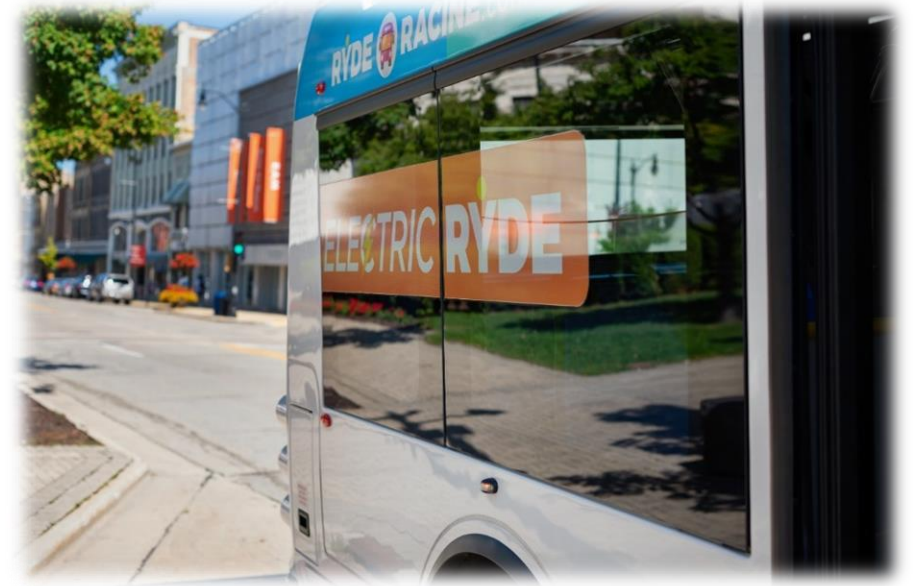

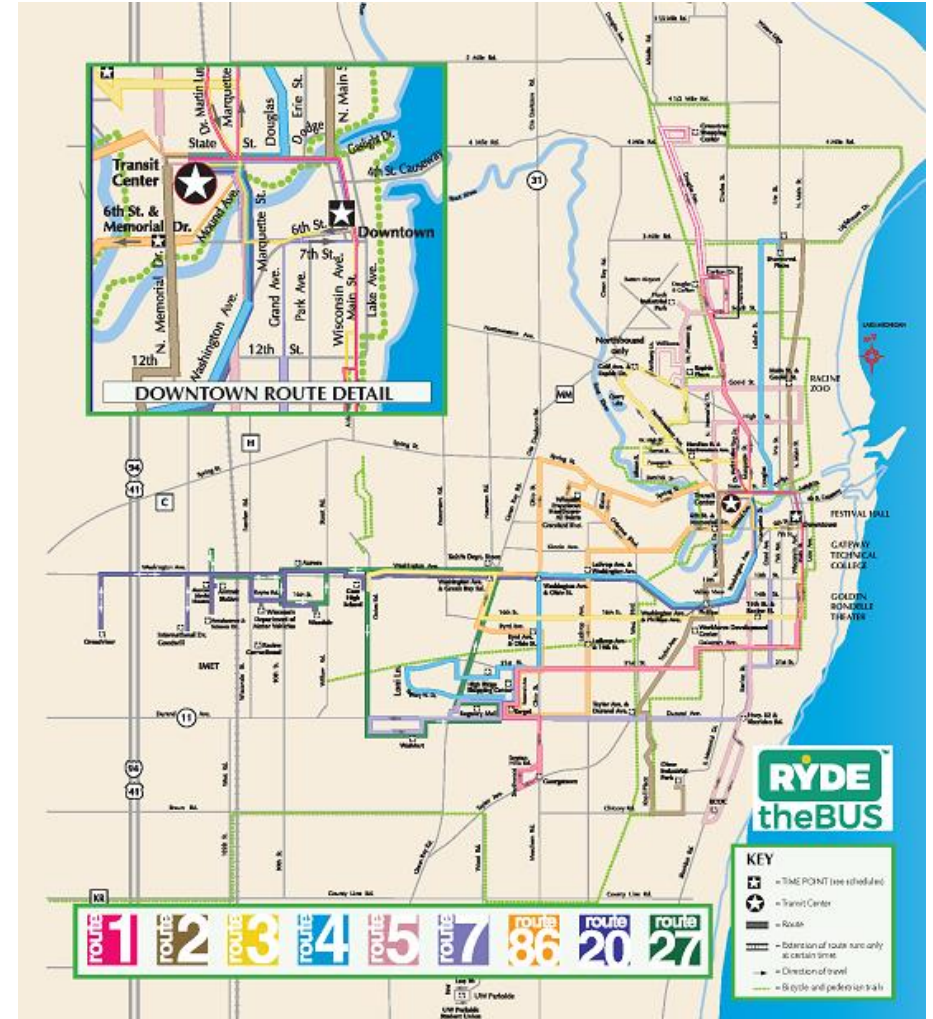
Public Transit in Greater Racine

Fixed Route

- 9 Routes: (60 mins), extra peak period service (30 mins)
- Additional Route for School Service (Route 30)
- 1 commuter route to Milwaukee and Kenosha

DART – Dial-A-Ride-Transit

- Minibus for persons with disabilities within 3/4 of a mile of a bus stop
