Thursday, July 6, 2023

Michelle's - 1863 Taylor Ave- Suspicious person- A named complainant (owner) called about someone walking around the building and leading on the front door. While officers were enroute the owner called back and stated the party was seen walking away from the tavern. Officer stayed in the area while the owner and staff left for the night.

Uptown Pub and Grill- 1510 Junction Ave- Man with a gun- A refused complainant called about a patron at the tavern "flashing a gun". Upon officers arrival they located a party that matched the description given to dispatch. Officers were able to detain the party and did not locate a firearm on their person. Upon further investigation it was found a small verbal argument occurred outside but was resolved without incident. Upon speaking with parties inside of the tavern at no point did anyone see a firearm inside of the tavern or outside. This man with a gun complaint was unfounded.

Scores- 4915 Washington Ave- Tavern Check- An officers self-initiated a call for service to conduct a tavern check. Officers found the Class B license was expired and the tavern did not have the current license displayed. Officers mentioned that was the only violation they observed and the tavern was given a verbal warning.

Doobie's Beer Joint- 3701 Douglas Ave- An officer conducted a self-initiated call for service to conduct a tavern check. The officers spoke with **23-027385** the bartender who did not have their bartender's license readily available for officers. In addition the tavern had the expired Class B license posted. The owner arrived on scene and was able to provide his new valid Class B license, which was under the expire one. The owner also stayed at the tavern due to being unable to locate the bartender's license.
