Highlights:

- 9/19/07 Ms. Michele Breheim facilitated the printing and distribution of pandemic influenza informational flyers in the Racine Penny Saver. The flyer included educational information regarding the "flu" and how citizens can prepare.
- North Beach and Zoo Beach officially closed on September 4, 2007. Zoo Beach had one closure day. North Beach had three (3) advisory days and Zoo Beach had six (6) advisory days.

Outcome Achievements:

- Two hundred and fifty seven (257) children tested for lead poisoning had blood lead levels between zero and nine ug/dL (0-9 ug/dL).
- Preliminary reports identify that ninety two (92) children were <u>first</u> tested for lead poisoning; three (3) had an elevated blood lead level (>9ug/dL), or 3.3%.
- Preliminary reports identify a <u>total</u> of two hundred and fifty five (255) children as being tested for lead poisoning; twenty (20) had an elevated blood lead level (>9ug/dL), or 7.8%.
- The number of 2007 city dog licenses obtained to date is four thousand two hundred twenty five (4225).
- The number of 2007 cat licenses obtained to date is nine hundred thirty three (933).
- Ninety-six (96) pet fanciers' permits have been issued in 2007.
