Subject: Communication from Mayor Mason presenting a request on behalf of the City of Racine Sustainability and Conservation Coordinator to amend the Solar Ground Lease Agreement approved by the Common Council on May 5, 2020, under Item 0243-20, with Wisconsin Electric Power Company, a Wisconsin corporation, doing business as We Energies. The funds will be used to conduct disease investigations and contact tracing for a wide variety of communicable diseases.
