Fiscal Note: This action allocates \$1,262,488 of Community Development Block Grant funds and \$157,979 in Emergency Solutions Grant funds in accordance with the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan. Sufficient funding exists to incur the budgeted expenses.

Fiscal Note: The Annual Action Plan is a requirement for receipt of community development funding from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. The plan anticipates receipt of \$1,876,297 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), \$573,953 in HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and \$160,724 in Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding in 2021.
