Dear Property Owner:

The City of Racine Planning, Heritage and Design Commission has received an application from Racine Recovery seeking a conditional use permit to operate a tow yard, at 2817 & 2811 Eaton Lane, as allowed by Sec. 114-568 of the Municipal Code.

They would pave a majority of the current lot with gravel for the storage of the towed vehicles. Their hours of operation will be 8-5 Monday – Friday and 8-12 Saturday.

The subject property is zoned I-1 Restricted Industrial District. The specific location is shown as "Subject Property" on the map on the reverse side of this page (flip page over).

A public hearing has been scheduled by the Planning, Heritage and Design Commission for **Wednesday, April 27, 2022 at 4:30 p.m., or soon thereafter**. The hearing will be held in Room 205 of Racine City Hall 730 Washington Avenue Racine, WI 53403.
