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**SUBJECT:** : Communication sponsored by Alder Taft on behalf of the City Attorney's Office submitting the claim of Allstate Insurance, on behalf of Renee A. Pavlovich, for disallowance.

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**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Allstate Insurance filed a claim, on behalf of Renee A. Pavlovich, with the City alleging \$7,362.14 in damages resulting from a November 3, 2021 car accident on Durand Street involving a dump truck owned by Racine County. Because the offending vehicle was owned and operated by Racine County, the City denies liability and recommends disallowance of this claim.

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**BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:**

Allstate Insurance filed a claim, on behalf of Renee A. Pavlovich, with the City alleging \$7,362.14 in damages resulting from a November 3, 2021 car accident on Durand Street involving a dump truck owned by Racine County.

This accident did not involve any City vehicles or employees. Rather it involved a dump truck owned and operated by Racine County. Therefore, the City has no liability for this accident.

The City has notified the claimant that it should present its claim to Racine County for consideration.

In sum, because the offending vehicle was owned and operated by Racine County, the City denies liability and recommends disallowance of this claim.
