Targeted Brownfields Assessment Program for
1500 N. Memorial Drive*

RESOLUTION NO. 22-19

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority/Community Development Authority of the City of Racine (CDA) owns property at 1500 N. Memorial Drive that, in its present state, constitutes a brownfield site in need of assessment to determine potential cleanup strategies; and

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) offers a Targeted Brownfields Assessments program that assists communities in assessing potential brownfield sites and determine potential cleanup options for the sites.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Community Development Authority of the City of Racine approves the application to the U.S. EPA for its Targeted Brownfields Assessment program; and

HEREBY AUTHORIZES, the Acting Executive Director and/or Chairman, or their designee(s), to act on behalf of the CDA to: sign all documents and take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete approved grant application activities.

Fiscal Note: The costs of the site assessments may range from \$50,000 - \$100,000. If the application is approved, the funding will be provided by the U.S. EPA. There are no funds requested from the City or its CDA to conduct these assessment activities.
