Highlights

Date	Meeting	Purpose	Outcome
May 2022	Greening Greater Racine (GGR)	2022 AmeriCorps Application	A second, full application was submitted by GGR in the hopes of acquiring an AmeriCorps crew to assist with beach restoration activities.
May 2022	Colonial Park	Herbicide Application	PHD staff received a herbicide permit for treatment of the wetland areas at Colonial Park for invasive plant species. The first round of herbicide was applied.
May 2022	Multiple Public Health Jurisdictions	Beach Monitoring	PHD staff engaged local public health departments concerning the beach monitoring within their jurisdictions. The collection of the first set of water samples was May 26 th .
May 2022	Great Lakes Community Conservation Corps/Veterans Corps	North Beach Fence Replacement	PHD staff engaged and requested the services of the Great Lakes Community Conservation Corps/Veterans Corps to replace the existing snow fencing at North Beach behind Kid's Cove. The new post and rope style fencing will be the same style used at Sam Myers and will assist with keeping individuals on the cordwalk path rather than walking through the dunes.
May 2022	Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC)	Wetland Delineation Assistance	PHD staff met with SEWRPC representatives to discuss the wetlands and delineation assistance.
